






THALASSEMIA BAL SEWA YOJNA

Clinical Requirements:

Thalassemia Matched Sibling Donor (MSD)

- Patient should have transfusion dependent Thalassemia
- Patient should have 100% HLA (Human Leukocyte Antigen) matched sibling donor
- Patient must be other than Class IIIB, liver size of the patient to be less than 5 cm below the coastal margin

Thalassemia Matched **Unrelated Donor (MUD)**

- Patient should have transfusion dependent Thalassemia
- Patient should have 100% HLA (Human Leukocyte Antigen) matched unrelated donor
- Patient must be other than Class IIIB, liver size of the patient to be less than 5 cm below the coastal margin

Aplastic Anaemia

- Patient should have severe Aplastic Anaemia as documented by a bone marrow examination
- Patient should have 6/6 HLA (Human) Leukocyte Antigen) matched related donor
- Necessary test for ruling out inherited bone marrow failure syndromes are to be done
