सीआईएल की एन्यूटी स्कीम-2020 से मिलेगा मुहूर विस्थापितों को लाभ!

- कई श्रेणियों में किया गया है विभाजन

निगाही कोयला खदान विस्तार के लिए अर्जित की गई ग्राम मुहूर की भूमि एवं परिसम्पत्तियों के सर्वेक्षण के संबंध में एक त्रिपक्षीय बैठक की गई। निगाही महाप्रबंधक सभागार में की गई बैठक में विस्थापितों की ओर से डेढ़ दर्जन मांगों को समस्याप्रद बताया और उनमें से एक थी कि यदि विस्थापित नौकरी करने लायक न हो तो उसे भत्ता दिया जाए। जिसके जवाब में कहा गया कि सीआईएल एन्यूटी स्कीम-2020 के प्रावधानों के तहत यदि विस्थापित इच्छुक है तो पात्रता के अनुसार एन्यूटी दी जायेगी। यह एन्यूटी स्कीम कोल इंडिया लि.-2020 भूमि के एवज में सीधे नौकरी या वन टाइम मोनेटरी कम्पनसेशन के परिप्रेक्ष्य में बनायी गयी है। जिसके लिए अभी तक एक भी आवेदन नहीं आए हैं, कम्पनी को सीधे तौर पर स्पष्ट दिशा निर्देश भी जारी नहीं किया जाना बताया जा रहा है। लेकिन यदि

सीबीए एक्ट ए एंड डी-2013 के मामले में पहली अनुसूची के तार एक्ट-20123 के अनुसार प्रभावितों को भूमि का मूल्य दिया जाना है। साथ ही यदि वे एन्यूटी स्कीम के तहत लाभ लेना चाहें तो 150 रुपये प्रति डिसमिल के मान से न्यूनतम 2000 प्रतिमा और अधिकतम 30000 रुपये प्रति माह 30 वर्षों तक अथवा प्रोजेक्ट के जीवन काल तक दिए जाने का प्रावधान किया गया है। जिसमें एक प्रतिशत प्रतिवर्ष बढ़ोतरी की जायेगी अथवा कन्ज्यूमर प्राइस इंडेक्स के अनुसार कृषि श्रमिकों को देय 2000 अथवा जो अधिक हो वही पात्रता होगी।

फिर भी विस्थापितों को सीआईएल की एन्यूटी स्कीम-2020 को लाभ मिलेगा तो इससे काफी हद तक नौकरी और विवादों में राहत मिल सकेगी। यह स्कीम एकमुश्त लाभ के साथ मासिक आय को भी निर्धारित करने वाली है। इस स्कीम को मौजूद लार एक्ट व अन्य प्रावधानों के सापेक्ष तैयार किया गया है, जिससे कि किसी भी भू-विस्थापित को समयानुसार लाभ मिल सके। वह अपने जॉब के अलावा वार्षिक लाभ का विकल्प चुन सकता है। इसके लिए उसे आरएफसीटीएलएआरआर-2013

(लार एक्ट) के तहत पात्रता होनी चाहिए। जिसके लिए कोयला मंत्रालय के गाइड लाइन अथवा चिन्हित भूमि के मूल्य अथवा सीधे तौर पर ली गई भूमि के अनुसार भूमि के अनुसार होनी चाहिए। प्रभावित परिवार को जिसकी सम्पत्ति अर्जित की जा रही है उसे कम्पनी और प्रदेश सरकार की नीति के योग्य होना चाहिए। इस स्कीम में अनुसूचित जनजाति व वन भूमि पर परंपरागत रूप से निर्भर लोगों को जिला प्रशासन के अनुमोदन पश्चात लाभ दिए जाने का प्रावधान किया गया है।

2000 से कम नहीं होगी मासिक आय | इस स्कीम के तहत प्रोजेक्ट के जीवन काल अथवा 20 वर्षों तक जो भी अधिक हो 2000 रुपये प्रतिमाह से कम आय नहीं होगी। अनुसूचित जनजाति व अन्य परंपरागत वन आधारित लोगों को भी इस स्कीम का लाभ दिए जाने का प्रावधान किया गया है। हालांकि जिले में अर्जित की गई भूमि के उपरंत इस स्कीम के तहत यदि मुहूर के विस्थापितों को इस स्कीम का लाभ मिलता है तो उनके लिए काफी लाभप्रद होगा।

सितंबर 2020 में जारी हुई थी स्कीम- इस स्कीम को सीआईएल बोर्ड की 409वीं बैठक में कोलकाता में जारी किया गया था जिसका आशय भूमि के बदले सीधे नौकरी अथवा एक ही बार में कम्पनसेशन देना था। जिसके प्रचार प्रसार का प्रयास नहीं होने से अभी तक इसकी जानकारी प्रभावितों को नहीं हो पायी है। कई बार तो इसे महज एक झूट बताया जाता रहा है।

Coal India in talks with Rio Tinto for Rs 30K cr aluminium joint venture

State-owned Coal India Ltd has started discussions with mining conglomerate Rio Tinto to set up a 300-bln-rupee aluminium manufacturing plant in Odisha, people in the know told Informist.

Coal India may offer Rio Tinto 74% stake in the proposed joint venture and will also facilitate obtaining regulatory clearances, along with mine and land acquisition, the sources said.

"Rio Tinto has expertise in aluminium making, and we need a technology partner as well for this project," a source in Coal India said.

Coal India has written to the government of Odisha seeking a bauxite mine in the state on nomination basis, the sources said. India's mining law requires mines to be auctioned to companies, but al-



lows public sector companies to get them on a nomination basis.

An e-mail sent to Coal India seeking details went unanswered.

Coal India, though, could get the mine on a nomination basis and offer it as part of its equity in the joint venture, the sources said. That could ensure compliance with the existing mining laws.

Coal India intends to set up the joint venture through subsidiary Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd, which accounts for 20% of the company's consolidated revenue.

CIL PRODUCES 64.3 MTS OF COAL IN FEB

STATE owned Coal India Limited on Tuesday informed that it has produced 64.3 million tonnes (MTs) of coal in February, a growth of 4% compared to the year ago period.

The company said its all out efforts are focused on ending this fiscal in the realm of 630 MTs. The total production of

coal last year in February was 61.9 MTs.

"Month-on-month, CIL's average production increased to 2.3 MTs per day in February'22. So, despite being three days lesser than January the sequential production in February was at par with the previous month," said CIL in a statement.

The company said its production at 542.4 MTs during April-

February fiscal year 22 was a historic high for this period. Coal output surged ahead by 27.3 MTs in absolute terms on a year-on-year comparison.

"The company expects to post the highest ever production by the closure of FY'22, going past the previous high of 607 MTs recorded in FY'19" said a senior executive of the company.

CIL's off-take in February

has recorded a strong 12% double-digit growth at 57.4 MTs against the same month last year.

The gain in absolute terms was 6.2 MTs. Progressive till February FY'22, CIL's total off-take was nearly 600 MTs. The company said earlier only once the off-take has crossed that mark when CIL despatched 608 MTs in FY'19, which is highest to the date.

नयी दिल्ली सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र की कोल इंडिया लिमिटेड का कोयला उत्पादन फरवरी 2022 में चार प्रतिशत बढ़ कर 6.43 करोड़ टन पर पहुंच गया. इससे पिछले वर्ष के इसी महीने में कंपनी ने 6.19 करोड़ टन कोयला का उत्पादन किया था. कोल इंडिया ने मंगलवार को एक बयान में बताया कि अपने उत्पादन को बढ़ाते हुए उसने फरवरी 2022 में 6.43 करोड़ टन कोयले का उत्पादन किया है. पिछले महीने की तुलना में फरवरी में कंपनी का औसत उत्पादन बढ़ कर 23 लाख टन प्रतिदिन हो गया. जनवरी से तीन दिन कम होने के बावजूद, फरवरी में कंपनी का उत्पादन पिछले महीने के बराबर था. कंपनी ने 63 करोड़ टन उत्पादन का लक्ष्य रखा है.

CIL to retain ownership of 100 closed mines to be put on offer for mining

New Delhi, March 2

THE 100 CLOSED Coal India mines the coal ministry has proposed offering for resumption of operation will be kept under the ownership of the PSU miner, though offered for production via an auction bidding route.

"The ownership of the mines will be retained by Coal India. It will be in the model of mine developer and operator (MDO) that coal will be mined under revenue-sharing basis. There will be no transfer of ownership of the mines," a senior CIL executive told *FE*. The executive added that the entire idea is to add more coal to the country's energy basket and extract the reserves to its fullest. This would also fetch revenue to CIL from assets lying ideal.

CIL had closed down certain mines over the years for reasons like surface constraints, financial unviability, political unrest and others despite extractable reserves remaining.

CIL's panning and designing arm, Central Mine Planning and Design Institute (CMPDI) has been engaged to identify such mines with a mandate that only such mines

would be put on offer to MDOs with mining life of at least 10-15 years.

While CMPDI was in the process of identifying such mines, extractable reserves would only be estimated when the mines are put up for auction in phases for engagement of MDOs. The ministry has not yet fixed any timeline as to when the first phase of auction would be rolled out for selecting MDOs, a senior CMPDI executive said.

He said a model document has been prepared for offering such mines to which many stakeholders agreed to, including private-sector

power biggies like the Tatas, Reliance and the Adanis. For CIL operating such mines alone wouldn't be financially viable for the high wages it has to pay out. "The private sector has an inherent commercial advantage both in terms of payout

and productivity. It can employ funds to bring in advanced technology to extract coal from deeper seams," the CMPDI executive said. Technological advancement has prompted the government to take such a view, giving leverage to commercial mining and making more coal available in the open market, he added.

Coal India registers 4% growth in February production

State-run coal major Coal India Ltd has registered a marginal 4 per cent growth in production in the month of February this year. CIL's production in the month under review stood at 64.3 million tons compared with 61.9 million tons in the same month last year.

"Stepping up its output tempo, Coal India Limited (CIL) has produced 64.3 million tons (MTs) of coal in February'22, with a lead of 2.4 MTs compared to 61.9 MTs of corresponding month year ago," said a Press statement issued by CIL here.

Month-on-month, CIL's average production increased to 2.3 MTs per day in February 2022. So, despite being three days lesser than January, the



sequential production in February was at par with the previous month, it said.

Coal India's all out efforts are focused on ending financial year 2021-22 in the realm of 630 MTs, it added.

CIL's production at 542.4 MTs during April-February FY'22 was a historic high for this period. Coal output surged ahead by 27.3 MTs in absolute terms on a year-on-year comparison.

"The company expects to

New auction system may lift CIL revenue by Rs 1K cr

A new methodology for electronic auction of coal may earn Coal India Ltd additional revenue of 10 bln rupees every year, brokerage house Prabhudas Lilladher Pvt Ltd said in a report on the state-owned company.

Under the new system, there is a single window for all buyers, scrapping the discount power generation companies used to get on reserve price.

The brokerage's estimate on additional revenue is based on likely extra realisation of 250 rupees per tn on 40 mln tn of auction to the power sector.

Earlier, the reserve price was 15% lower for power sector than other segments such as steel and



cement to help keep price of electricity under check. Also, 40% of the total auction volume was reserved for the power sector.

"Under (the) new policy, Coal India would be able to exploit strong demand from non-power sectors amidst sharp increase in global prices," Prabhudas Lilladher said.

Global coal prices have hit record highs due to Russia-Ukraine conflict. Russia, which is one of the biggest supplier of energy to rest of the Europe, is now facing sanctions.

CIL, BHEL to partner on coal gasification

New Delhi, March 4

Reinforcing the government's commitment towards green initiatives in the coal sector, Coal India and Bharat Heavy Electricals will collaborate for coal gasification.

"Coal Ministry aims to have 100 million tonnes of coal gasification by 2030 through sustainable utilisation. For this, CIL has taken up four projects, which were announced in the Union Budget for 2022-23 to help firm up technical and financial viability of these projects. Experts said that for coal gasification and carbon capture, India should bank on indigenous technology to make it reliable and affordable," the Ministry said in a statement.

In August 2020, Coal Min-

ister Pralhad Joshi said that India aims for 100 mt of coal gasification by 2030 with ₹4-lakh crore investments.

Setting up a plant is capital-intensive, and requires at least 48 months. With the limited experience available in India, it is crucial to ensure the success of initial projects for the national mission.

To implement the project, it has been planned to set up gasification projects in phases. In phase I, a project based on low ash coal available in CIL will be taken up. The mining giant will take care of mining of coal and marketing and the gasification and product conversion plant will be set up on BOO/BOM/LSTK contract basis.

However, considering the dearth of low ash coal, gasi-

fication plants will be set up based on high ash coal.

Coal reserves

India has a huge reserve of about 344 billion tonne of non-coking coal, out of which about 163 bt are proven reserves. With the current consumption, it is expected to last for over five decades. About 80 per cent is used in thermal power plants, accounting for around 55 per cent of the power generated.

Cleaner fuel

Coal gasification is considered a cleaner option compared to burning of coal. Syngas, produced from gasification, can be used to produce gaseous fuels such as hydrogen, substitute natural gas (SNG or Methane) and Di-Methyl Ether (DME).

Coal supplies to power sector peaked to record 493 mt: CIL

Supplies 90 mt more to power sector compared with the same period last year

Coal India Ltd's (CIL) supplies to power sector peaked to a record high of 493 million tonnes (mt) as on March 3 of the ongoing fiscal breaching the previous high of 491.5 mt that it had recorded in FY19.

During April-February, the CIL had supplied 90 mt more coal to power sector when compared to the corresponding period last year. With stepping up supplies in the remainder of March, CIL aims to close the fiscal with 548 mt off-take to power sector as projected by the Central Electricity Authority, the company said.

CIL's despatch to this major coal consuming sector was at

488 mt at the end of February, representing a 23 per cent growth compared to 398 mt in the same period of FY21.

"The major challenge for CIL during the year was adjusting to the unpredictability of the coal demand. The coal-based power generation witnessed a muted growth in previous two fiscals. Then it had risen sharply to 11.2 per cent till January'22 compared to the same period a fiscal ago. However, the company had managed to push additional quantities of coal," the release said.

The state-owned miner posted a 22 per cent growth in supplies to power sector at 48.4 mt in February this year as compared to the same period last year.

The current coal stock of 43 mt at CIL's pitheads is expected to increase further by FY22 end. This would help the company gear up to meet the summer coal demand.

Coal supply to power plants surge

Calcutta: Coal India on Friday said supplies to the power sector have hit a record high of 493 million tonnes (mt) for a fiscal year even with 28 days left to go in March. The previous high was 491.5mt in 2018-19.

Supply to the power sector in the 11 months of April-February rose 23 per cent annually to 488mt from 398mt.

The miner said a major challenge was to adjust supplies to the fluctuating demand from the generators.

After a muted growth for two years, coal-based power generation rose sharply by 11.2 per cent till January from a year ago.

This required Coal India to push additional quantities of coal for thermal power generation. Coal India produced 542.4mt till February, an increase of 11 per cent.

Total offtake during the 11 months rose to 600mt from 514.4mt a year ago.

Coal India officials said they expect both production and offtake to hit a record this fiscal. Supplies to power had hit the peak on March 3.

CIL's pithead coal may rise further by FY22-end

STATE-OWNED CIL on Friday said the current coal stock of 43 million tonnes (MT) at its pithead is likely to increase further by the end of the current financial year and this will help the company gear up for meeting the coal demand of summer which is on the advent.

Coal India Ltd (CIL) accounts for over 80 per cent of the overall domestic coal output.

"The current coal stock of 43 MT at CIL's pitheads is expected to increase further by FY22-end," the state-owned company said in a statement.

The fuel supply by CIL to the power sector peaked to a historic high of 493 million tonnes (MT) as on Thursday in the ongoing fiscal, breaching the previous high of 491.5 MT that

the Maharatna coal miner recorded in FY19.

The public sector undertaking (PSU) could achieve the feat with 28 days still to go before the fiscal's end, CIL said in a statement.

During the April-February period of the current fiscal, CIL supplied 90 MT more coal to the power sector than it did during the corresponding period last year.

CIL's coal despatch stood at 488 MT to this major coal-consuming sector ending February 2022. This represents a sizeable growth of around 23 per cent, compared with 398 MT during the year-ago period.

Stepping up on supplies in the remainder of March, CIL aims to close the fiscal with 548 MT offtake to the power sector as projected by the Central Electricity Authority. – PTI

कोयले के कुल घरेलू उत्पादन में 80 फीसदी से अधिक योगदान कोल इंडिया लिमिटेड का रहता है। कंपनी ने एक बयान में कहा, 'सीआईएल की खदानों के पास अभी 4.3 करोड़ टन कोयला भंडार है जो चालू वित्त वर्ष के अंत तक और बढ़ जाएगा।'

सीआईएल की ओर से ऊर्जा क्षेत्र को ईंधन की आपूर्ति वृहस्पतिवार को चालू वित्त वर्ष में 49.3 करोड़ टन के ऐतिहासिक उच्च स्तर पर पहुंच गई। इससे पहले आपूर्ति का सर्वाधिक 49.15 करोड़ टन का स्तर 2018-19 में था।

कोयला कंपनी ने एक बयान में कहा कि चालू वित्त वर्ष समाप्त होने में अभी कई दिन बाकी हैं, ऐसे में वह इस लक्ष्य को हासिल कर सकती है। चालू वित्त वर्ष की अप्रैल से फरवरी की अवधि के दौरान सीआईएल ने, पिछले वित्त वर्ष की समान अवधि की तुलना में ऊर्जा क्षेत्र को 9 करोड़ टन अतिरिक्त कोयले की आपूर्ति की। फरवरी 2022 तक सीआईएल ने ऊर्जा क्षेत्र को 48.8 करोड़ टन कोयले की आपूर्ति की जो एक वर्ष पहले की 39.8 करोड़ टन की आपूर्ति की तुलना में 23 फीसदी अधिक है।
