Coal India floats 5 GW renewable power tenders

Singapore: Coal India has issued tenders to build 3 GW of solar and 2 GW of wind power plants, its most significant move yet to diversify revenue sources amid a decline in output this year due to tepid demand. The company currently has an installed solar capacity of about 0.2 GW, and plans to increase that to 3 GW by 2028 and 9.5 GW by 2030. PTI
