Subject of Tender- Conclusion of Running Contracts (RCs) and empanelment as Reserve RC holders for a period upto 31.05.2027 for supply of Permitted Electronic Detonator to all the subsidiary companies of CIL and NEC.

The following NIT clauses may be read as under in place of existing entry:

1	ITB – Section II- Clause 29 – Distribution of quantity	Note – No provision	Note: Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in this tender, any bidder who does not possess valid DGMS approval for the offered product but is participating on the basis of DGMS approval for field trials in underground coal mines, if declared as a successful bidder, shall be eligible for allocation of not more than ten percent (10%) of the total tendered quantity, irrespective of such bidder's status as L1, L2, L3, or otherwise. Any quantity that would otherwise have been allocated to such bidder in excess of the aforesaid limit of ten percent (10%) of the tendered quantity shall be redistributed among the remaining eligible proven successful bidders possessing valid DGMS approval for the offered product, in accordance with the applicable quantity distribution methodology and ratios prescribed in the relevant clauses above. Example: Tender quantity = 1000 units There are four eligible bidders. Normal distribution as per clause is 40:30:20:10

			Say L1 bidder is a successful bidder without DGMS approval of the product, distribution shall be capped at 100 units (10%). At this point distribution would be: • L1 (bidder without DGMS approval of product) = 100 (capped) • L2 = 300 • L3 = 200 • L4 = 100 700 units have been allocated, leaving 300 units to be redistributed within the group of three eligible bidders (L2:L3:L4::50:30:20) as under: • L2: 50% = 150 • L3: 30% = 90 • L4: 20% = 60 Final allocation: • L1 (bidder without DGMS approval of product): 100 • L2: 300 + 150 = 450 • L3: 200 + 90 = 290 • L4: 100 + 60 = 160
2	SCC – Section IV	Clause 2.9 – No provision	Clause 2.9 – Failure to Obtain DGMS Approval and Commence Supplies: If a RC holder (bidder without DGMS approval of product) fails to obtain DGMS approval for the product and/or commence supplies within two (2) months from the date of award of the RC, the Purchaser shall have the right to short-close the RC. In such an event, the Security Deposit shall be liable to be forfeited/encashed. Where the Security Deposit has not been furnished by the RC holder after issuance of the RC, the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be liable to be forfeited/encashed, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies available to the Purchaser under the terms of the RC or applicable law.
