Sub: Revised Rate of DA for the Contractor's Workers engaged in Mining Activities

The Ministry of Labour & Employment vide order No. 1/13(4)2017 LS-II dated 20/04/2017 revised the rates of Variable Dearness Allwance on the basis of Average Consumer Price Index No. for the preceding period of 06 months ending on 01.04.2017 reaching 277.5 from 202.83 (Nil) (Base 2001=100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 74.67 points for industrial workers. This order shall come in force w.e.f. 01.04.2017.

In terms of clause (b) of recommendation of High Power Committee (HPC), the rates of variable dearness allowance including rates of wages for contractor's workers engaged in mining activities as per the recommendation of HPC, in which it is defined under section 2(h), (j) and (k) of Mines Act 1952 including washery, CHP and railway sidings, the rate of VDA payable per day w.e.f. 01.04.2017 will be as under: -

Therefore, the minimum rates of wages showing the basic rates and variable dearness allowance payable w.e.f. 01.04.2017 will be as under: -

Semi Skilled/ Unskilled Supervisory	494.00+56.00 550
Skilled	<u>524.00+67.00</u> 591

Other terms and conditions mentioned in the recommendations of the High Power Committee shall remain the same.
