The process of Phasing out has been initiated in the year 2020 with a target to phase out Electric Detonators by 1st April 2025. Further Extension of Phasing out of Electric Detonators have been further extended till 30.09.2025.  Several meetings with prospective suppliers in the presence of DPIIT, DGMS and PESO were held and sensitivity and importance of the matter was brought to their notice time and time again.

Request:  We request that parties having field trial approval from PESO should also be considered eligible to  submit bids.  Proposed Amendment:	Sufficient time has been provided for prospective bidders to develop the product and get DGMS approval of Field trials.  Considering the teething stage of the product, special eligibility criteria has already been incorporated as per NIT which was also discussed at length during the Pre-NIT meeting.
" DGMS Field trials in underground coal mines from DGMS as on last date of bid submission or field trial approval from PESO shall also be considered for submission of bid ore only eligible."	
We understand that the tender has incorporated certain special considerations in the eligibility criteria to promote broader participation. The above amendment would further enhance competition and encourage participation from technically qualified vendors who are currently in the final stages from various agencies.
