

Minutes of the Inter-active session with Power Producers for successful implementation of 3rd Party samplers at SECL HQ, Bilaspur on dated 27.10.2014.

At the outset, Shri R.P.Thakur, Director Technical (Operations), SECL welcomed all representatives of the Power Producers for attending this meeting which has been called for compliance of directive as per ref no. CEA/Plg./OM/1/1/2014/1344-60 dated 25.08.2014 issued by Director (OM), CEA. He deliberated in details the purposes and intent of this meeting. DT (O) assured them that all the genuine demands, grievances, complaints of the consumers will be dealt with priority and invited the representatives to express their views. He also assured that SECL will take them in true spirit and will take all possible measures to resolve the issues within the rules and regulations/directives of MOC and CIL.

Out of 31 Power Houses which has FSA with SECL were intimated regarding meeting; only 25 representatives of 12 Power Houses attended the Inter-active session.

• DSPM, CSPGCL

CSPGCL informed that they have no problem in the present system of sample collection, preparation and analysis and they want to remain with existing joint sampling. They raised quality issues of Junadih siding where joint sampling are not being done properly sometimes.

DT (O), SECL advised QC dept. to examine the case and resolve the issue.

• Korba (East), CSPGCL

They informed that they are satisfied with the present system of Coal sampling and analysis and there is no need for any Third Party Sampling. However, proper communication and interaction between both the parties should be done to resolve all the quality related issues.

Korba (West)/HTPS, CSPGCL

He informed that no intimation about the Third Party Agency has been received either by their plant or HQ. As such, not in a position to say anything in this regards and requested for 4-5 days to revert back.

✓ India Bulls

India Bulls has already implemented the Third Party Agency.

EMCO Energy

They have no quality issue. However, they require clarifications over the issues of engaging 3rd party sampler.

Adani Power Ltd.

He praised the efforts of SECL regarding appoint of 3rd party samplers at loading end. He informed that they will study the whole matter and revert back.

✓ MPPGCL HQ / SGTPS Birsinghpur, MPPGCL

He enquired about the difference between Joint Sampling and Third Party Sampling and further mentioned that the proper sampling procedures are not being followed at loading point as per FSA. They informed that they have already appointed CIMFR, Bilaspur as 3rd party sampler.

✓ NTPC, Korba & Sipat

Representatives from NTPC, Korba and Sipat attended the meeting. He informed that as per Govt. directives, NTPC will appoint Third Party Agency. We had sought some clarification from CIL. But no response has been received so far. As soon as reply from CIL is received, NTPC will appoint Third Party Agency within a month.

✓ Jindal Power Ltd.

He expressed his thanks to SECL for this meeting. He informed that they have already engaged M/s. S.K.Mitra & Co. as their Third Party Agency. He raised quality issues of the coal supplied to them as one time lifting.

DT (O), SECL advised QC dept. to examine the case and resolve the issue.

Nabha Power Ltd.

He informed that they are getting washed coal from SECL. For appointment of Third Party Agency, they will revert back later on.


