


Comparative Provisions arising out of changes due to introduction of Third Part Sampling in place of Joint Sampling and analysis system for:

8.1 - (Both for existing and new models)	In the event the Purchaser is desirous of availing joint sampling, such facility shall be allowed at the Delivery Point only and for the Coal produced from Seller's own sources and not for Imported Coal, if any. All such joint sampling and analysis for determination of Coal quality shall be done in accordance with the relevant BIS Standards and as prescribed under this Clause and Schedule V of this agreement.	In the event the Purchaser is desirous of availing <i>Third Party</i> sampling, such facility shall be allowed at the Delivery Point only and for the Coal produced from Seller's own sources and not for Imported Coal, if any.
